

#### APPENDIX A. BOTTLE MACHINE SET-UP

#### SPECIAL VENDING MODE


When properly set up, your bottle machine can vend two items (a snack and a drink) for a single price which can be lower than the sum of the two selections purchased individually. This is accomplished by a customer vending either a "G" or "J" selection. The G and J trays do not physically exist, but represent a combination of selections from other trays. (G = A+E, and J = B+E) For example, selecting G2 will vend the A2 and E2 selections; selecting J3 will vend the B3 and F3 selections.


IF YOU DO NOT WANT TO USE THIS MODE, don't set G and J prices to zero unless you want people getting free drinks and snacks. It is important that you do one (or both) of the following:

- Set artificially high prices for the G and J "trays". See procedure P1-2 in your Programming Guide. If someone presses a G or J selection, the machine will display the price you set, which will discourage someone from purchasing the combination.
- Lock out the G and J "trays". See procedure P6-3 and the Event Editing Procedure in your Programming Guide. Inhibit vending the G and J "trays" between 00:00 and 23:59 (midnight and 11:59 pm) on Sunday through Saturday.

#### "E TRAY" SPIRAL ALIGNMENT

The spiral coupler can be installed in the motor gear box in one of six positions. Be sure you install the spiral and spiral coupler in either the "SIX O'CLOCK" or "EIGHT O'CLOCK" position as shown. Due to slight manufacturing differences, the spiral coupler may not be in exactly those positions. If this is the case, install the spiral coupler somewhere between those positions. In other words, "SIX O'CLOCK" and "EIGHT O'CLOCK" are the minimum and maximum positions.



#### **BOTTLE PLACEMENT**

Place plastic bottles into the spirals on the "E" tray as shown. The first bottle must be as close to the edge of the tray as possible for proper vending. Glass bottles should be placed upright on the "F" tray, but do not require as much special treatment. Once you have filled both bottle trays, perform numerous test vends until you are satisfied the bottles are vending properly. You may need to realign the spirals as shown above.



#### **VEND DOOR SWITCH OPERATION**

If a vend is made from the "F" tray, the vend door must be actuated and the bottle removed before another "F" selection can be vended. This prevents dropping one glass bottle on top of another one.
