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WARRANTY (LIMITED)

Polyvend Inc. warrants this equipment to the ORIGINAL PURCHASER only, for a period of one (1) year from date of shipment, to be free from significant defects in material or workmanship, three (3) years on electronic components and one (1) year on vending door solenoids and light ballast to the extent such parts are warranted to Polyvend Inc. except for starters, light bulbs and fuses, which will be warranted for two months from the date of shipment. The refrigeration system consisting of the compressor, fan motors, thermostat, starter, thermal overload, condenser coil, evaporator coil are warranted for a period of one (1) year to the extent those parts are warranted to Polyvend, Inc. Should a failure occur on the cooling system within the warranty period, the unit is to be replaced and the defective unit returned to Polyvend. No refrigeration work is to be performed on a refrigeration unit. If such unit has been tampered with in any form, the warranty on this unit is void.

Should any part prove defective within the warranted period, Polyvend, Inc. will repair or replace (at its option) the defective component, but will not provide the labor, removal or reinstallation costs associated with such parts. All returned products or parts must be shipped, freight prepaid, to Polyvend and Polyvend will then prepay the shipping cost of the returned goods. Polyvend reserves the right to refuse any collect shipment. Any part returned under the terms of this warranty should be accompanied with a brief description of the defect of failure along with the model number and serial number.

This warranty applies only if the equipment is serviced and maintained in strict accordance with the instructions given in the Polyvend Service Manual that no unauthorized repair or disassembly has been done. Any defect caused by improper source of power supplied, abuse of the product, accident, alteration, vandalism, mineral build-up or improper cleaning or service techniques will not be covered by warranty.

Polyvend service or repair to items not in warranty will be subject to the standard service charge for repair of the failed components. For warranty or service information call or wrote to Polyvend Service Department.



LEKTRO-VEND MODEL LVE-9 COLD FOOD MACHINE

The LEKTRO-VEND Series Model LVE-9 Cold Food Machine Is a revolutionary new concept in vending equipment where bigger is not always better. It is developed to help the Operator increase his competitive position and to service locations where the need for a large cold food machine is not necessary, but the customer requires refrigerated food. With this machine, a location can be provided with all types of refrigerated items in the smaller quantities keeping the out-of-date food items to a minimum.

This machine comes equipped with nine shelves for cold food. These shelves can be set up with any combination of compartments from four (4) to twelve (12) and each "shelf" regardless of the number of compartments, is priced individually. The product delivery doors on the cold food are locked by solenoids. When the correct amount of credit is established and a selection button is pressed the solenoid for the corresponding selection door will release allowing the door to be opened. The Shopper System allows the customer to select any available item. Pushing the Shopper Button ("Press to View") bar on the front of the machine will allow the carousel to move 30 degrees or the equivalent of one small compartment. Pushing the Shopper Button will allow the carousel to turn continuously. The shopper system will not operate when any on the of the following conditions exist:

- 1) A product door is open.
- 2) A vend is in progress.

INSTALLATION


- Remove all external packing material.
- Inspect equipment for shipping damage. If evident file claim immediately with the carrier (see Shipping Procedures).
- Remove key from coin return cup, unlock the service door and remove the shipping material.
- Check the operation of the service door and locking mechanism. They should operate smoothly and latch at all three locking plates.
- Make sure that the latch for the cold food door is functioning properly.
- Place machine into position and adjust leveling legs so the machine is level and all the legs sit firmly on the floor.
- It is extremely important to provide the machine with sufficient air flow for cooling. Provide a MINIMUM OF SIX (6) INCHES SPACING BETWEEN THE WALL AND THE BACK OF THE MACHINE.
- Install coin mechanism and bill validator as required.
- Plug service cord into 110VAC source using the three prong grounded plug provided. If a grounded outlet
 is not available, use a proper external ground on all locations.

NOTE: In order to comply with electrical safety regulations and Underwriters Laboratories requirements, all electrical equipment must be properly polarized and grounded. The Polyvend machine is wired so that it is properly polarized in accordance with the electrical code. If the wall outlet is wired and grounded properly, then the vending machine will connect properly.



Shown in views A and B are two properly grounded and polarized wall outlets. One is a three wire grounded type wall outlet (See View A) and the other is a two wire wall outlet (See View B) with an adapter in place.

Should the polarity at the wail outlet appear any way other that that shown below, the outlet should be rewired by qualified personnel.



NOTE: Polyvend Inc. is not responsible for faulty or overloaded circuits within the facility where Polyvend machines are installed. The exact load imposed by the machines is stated in the electrical specifications section. The sum of all devices connected to a particular circuit will determine the total line load. It is recommended that a separate electrical circuit be dedicated to these machines.

CAUTION: DISCONNECT POWER TO THE VENDING MACHINE BEFORE REMOVING THE CONTROL BOARD OR COIN CHANGER OR WORKING ON ANY ELECTRICAL COMPONENTS IN THE MACHINE.

- Test the coin mechanism and bill validator (If installed) to ensure smooth operation. If the operation of the coin mechanism is not smooth, check to make sure that you have proper alignment of the changer with the coin return lever.
- Load the coin tubes on the coin changer located on the front door of the machine. It is very important to fill the 25¢, 10¢ and 5¢ tubes for proper change pay back and operation of the bill validator (if installed). NOTE: The maximum amount of change a Coinco 9302LF will hold is \$38.60, \$23.00 in quarters, \$12.20 in dimes and \$3.40 in nickels. The maximum amount of change that a Mars TRC-6010XV will hold is \$29.95; \$16.75 in quarters, \$9.80 in dimes and 3.40 in nickels.
- Place the price stickers just above the selection number for each selection located to the right of each
 vend door. Set the prices of the products. (See price setting) Note: A changer must be installed in
 this machine in order to set prices in this machine. It is not necessary to have a bill validator installed in
 this machine for prices to be set. See page 7.
- Operate each vending dispenser, using coins. Operation should be smooth.
- In the large manila envelope is a sheet with the sticker "LOCATE FOOD HERE". Peel each sticker off
 and place it on the delivery door guide. The position should be in the center of the compartment that the
 selection will vend from. See page 7.



Pull the loading switch out, rotating the carousel and load the machine with product. The loading switch
is located on the inside of the refrigerated compartment on the left side at the top.

NOTE: It is imperative that the refrigerated compartment be pulled down to and cycling at the correct temperature (32 to 38 degrees F) prior to loading product.

- Check to make sure that the Vend Options are set to the desired settings. See section on Vend Options.
- There is a blower system designed to keep condensation from forming on the delivery doors. The system
 directs warm air across the delivery doors from the right side. Make sure that the blower is operating
 properly.




COLD FOOD SETUP

REMOVING TRAY HALVES

The tray halves can be easily removed to change the divider configuration for loading or for cleaning. They are removed by the following procedures:

1. Stop the carousel so that the tray section stops near the light fixture on the right side. See figure below.



- 2. Underneath the center of the tray half is a leaf spring that is holding a stud attached to the tray. Pull down on the spring to release the tray outward towards you.
- 3. The rear of the tray is inserted into a groove in the collar that is attached to the tray column. A slight forward pressure may be required to disengage the rear of the tray from the groove.
- 4. The tray lips are designed with tabs that extend beyond the back edge of the tray. These tabs slip underneath the adjoining tray half to lock the two halves together and provide support for each other.
- 4. When the tray half is removed you will notice that the 12 and 6 compartment trays have a security top with clips that slip through the top and over the dividers. After changing the dividers or cleaning the tray replace the security covers and clips. These are required to keep the dividers from being bent sideways and allowing the food from being removed from the next compartment.


CAUT!ON: Always replace the security clips to prevent too much movement by the dividers.



CHANGING DIVIDER POSITION

Divider positions can only be changed while the tray half is removed from the machine.

- 1. Remove the security top by removing the screw that holds each security clip in place and then remove the security clip. Once the security clips are removed, the security top can be lifted off the dividers.
- 2. Lift the rear of the divider first with a slight upward pressure. This allows the divider latch to slip out of the tray bottom. To replace the divider, reverse this sequence of steps.
- 3. Replace the security top and clips. Tighten each screw that holds the clips in place. Tray half is now ready to be installed in the machine.





PRODUCT LOADING

To access the food compartment of your machine, you must:

- 1. First open the main door as far as possible.
- 2. Release the inside door latch with the handle of the cold food door and open.


The carousel can then be rotated to the left by a two (2) position service switch located in the upper left hand corner of the cold food box.

- 1. Push the switch in once and the carousel will move 30 degrees (1/12 of a rotation) for easy loading from top to bottom.
- 2. Pull the switch out and the carousel will rotate continuously for loading one shelf at a time.
- 3. Pushing the switch in will stop the rotation.
- 4. Close the cold food door and latch.




CAROUSEL JAM

- 1. Should a carousel jam, loosen the wing nut on the shopper motor and bracket assembly until you can remove the chain from the sprocket.
- 2. Then take hold of one of the carousel trays and try to back up the carousel to un-jam it. Remove the cause of the jam.
- 3. Close the refrigerated door and check to make sure that the tray divider lines up with the right side of the vend door. If it does not line up, loosen the wing nut on the shopper motor and bracket assembly and move the chain over on the sprocket until the tray divider lines up with the right hand side of the vend door. After ensuring the proper alignment, tighten the wing nut down. Do not overtighten the chain or the carousel motor may bind up.





SOLENOID COVER PANEL REMOVAL




At some time, it may become necessary to remove the cover over the solenoids for service or maintenance. To remove the cover, open the front service door of the machine. Then unlatch and open the inside cold food door. Located on the back side of the cold food door is the solenoid cover. Take hold of the solenoid cover at the top and bottom and lift up firmly on the panel. The panel should move upward about 1/2" allowing you then to remove the panel. Set the cover out of the way. To reinstall the cover, simply reverse the process by repositioning the cover. Making sure that all points are latching, slide the cover downward about 1/2". Make sure that the cover is securely latched in place. If one of the latches is missed, the cover may rub on the carousel trays in that area. Close the front door and ensure that the cover is not rubbing against the carousel.



CHILLER ASSEMBLY REMOVAL

To remove the chiller assembly from the machine, disconnect the chiller power cord from the power box and remove it from the wire clamp. Locate the chiller lift rod (3/8" round rod) which is mounted on the lower left front side of the chiller rack assembly. Lift up on the lever, which will lower the chiller and chiller rack assembly. Grasp the handle on the front of the chiller and lift up to clear the lip on the front of the chiller rack. Pull the chiller forward until it clears the lower machine compartment.

To re-install chiller, set the back of the chiller on the front lip of the chiller rack assembly with the thermostat towards the front of the machine and slide the chiller back until the front edge of the chiller drops down behind the front lip of the chiller rack assembly. CAUTION: When slipping the chiller into place, verify that chiller is setting down inside the rack assembly and not up on one side. When chiller is properly positioned in the chiller rack assembly, pull forward and down on the lift lever which will raise the chiller up, sealing it against the bottom side of the cold food compartment. When the rod is brought to its most downward position, this will lock the lift lever into place preventing the chiller or rack assembly from lowering without first raising the lever. Reconnect the power cord to the power box assembly and secure the cord with the wire clamp to prevent damage.





ELECTRICAL SERVICE SECTION

MODES OF OPERATION

The system will operate in one of two modes, sales or service. On power up (after completing configuration), the machine is in the sales mode. Service mode may be selected by pressing the mode switch mounted on the control board. The system will return to the sales mode if the mode switch is pressed or after 25 seconds of no service mode activity.

SALES MODE

In the sales mode, the control board will control the dispensing of products according to customer credit and selection inputs. The control board will communicate with the coin mechanism and dollar bill validator (if installed) so, as credit is entered, it will be shown on the scrolling display. If there is inadequate change available, the coin mechanism will indicate that an exact change situation exists and the control board will illuminate the "Exact Change" light located just below the display.

When a customer makes a selection numbers 1 through 9, the accumulated credit will be compared to the price set for this selection and if the credit is equal to or exceeds the set price, the corresponding solenoid will be energized. If the vend is successful, the price will be deducted from the credit value and the change returned.

The vend will be considered unsuccessful if the vend solenoid does not receive sufficient current or fails to close within 12 seconds. The vend will not be attempted if the solenoid has already been detected as failed or if the machine selection made is not in the configuration of the machine. In any case, credit will not be deducted and the "Make Alternate Selection" light will flash until another selection is made.

If there is insufficient credit for the selection made, the price of that selection will be displayed for five (5) seconds, indicating additional money needs to be inserted. The person must either make another selection or enough credit is added. The price of the selection will be displayed during the vend.

If power should fail during a vend, the credit will be lost and the selected solenoid will drop back into the locked position. When power returns, the solenoid will NOT re-energize.

SERVICE MODE

The service mode can be entered by pressing the "MODE SWITCH" located on the control board on the right hand side. By pressing the mode button, you will step through the different modes of the control board.

DETAILED OPERATION OF CONTROL BOARD

At the time of delivery from Polyvend Inc. the control board will be set as follows:

- 1. All vend options will be off.
- The cash accountability will be set to \$00,000.00
 NOTE: Due to factory testing the total will not be exactly \$00,000.00
- The total number of vends will be 000000.
 NOTE: Due to factory testing the total will not be exactly 000000.
- 4. All prices will be set to \$00.50.



COIN DISPENSING (Ser 1)

Press the service mode switch one (1) time and Ser1 will appear on the digital display. Press selection button #1 and nickels will be dispensed out of the changer. Press button #2 to dispense dimes and selection button #3 to dispense quarters.

PRICE SETTING (Ser 2)

Press the service mode switch two (2) times and Ser2 will appear on the digital display. Press the selection button you wish to change the price of. Release the button and press it again and the price will go up in nickel increments. If you go past the price, release the selection button and press it again. To set the price of the next selection, press the selection number and repeat the price setting process. To return to the sales mode after setting all the prices, press the mode switch 6 times and 00 will appear on the display.

SERVICE VEND (Ser 3)

To service vend a selection, press the mode switch three (3) times. The digital display will show Ser3. Press the selection number of vend solenoid you wish to test. The solenoid should release and the vend door allowed to be opened. To test vend a second solenoid, press the selection button for that selection and the solenoid will release allowing you to open the vend door. To return to the sales mode, press the mode switch five times.

ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM (Ser 4)

To display the stored accountability, press the mode switch four (4) times. The digital display will show Ser4. For total cash accountability, press selection button #1 and the total amount of money the machine has taken in will be shown. To display the total number of vends for the machine, press selection button #2 to display the total vends by the machine. To return to the sales mode, press the mode switch four times. Note: This item is not resettable.

CASH ACCOUNTABILITY BY SELECTION (Ser 5)

To display the stored accountability, press the mode switch five (5) times. The digital display will show Ser5. For the total cash accountability for an individual selection, press the selection number you wish to check. The total sales for that selection will be displayed. To check an additional selection, press the selection number and the total cash accountability will be displayed. To return to the sales mode, press the mode switch three times.

TOTAL VENDS BY SELECTION (Ser 6)

To display the total number of vends by selection, press the mode button six (6) times. The digital display will show Ser6. For the total number of vends of a selection, press the selection number. The total number of vends for that selection will be displayed. To check another selection, press the selection number of the selection you wish to check. To return to the sales mode, press the mode switch two times.



VEND OPTIONS (Ser 7)

To enable or disable the vend option, press the mode switch seven (7) times. The digital display will show Ser7. Press selection button #1 to check the status of the Forced Vend feature. To change the status of this feature, press selection button #1 and the feature will be changed (example: feature is "on" it will then be turned "off"). Press selection button #2 for the status of the Multi-vend. To change the status of this feature, press selection button #2 and the feature will be changed. To return to the sale mode, press the mode witch one time.

ERROR CODES

Er = 1 - Door is openEr = 2 - High Temp error

HEALTH SAFETY RESET

This machine has a high temperature sensor called a health safety. Should the temperature inside the refrigerated area be above 45 degrees, the health safety will shut down the machine. The carousel will not rotate, changer will not accept money and the indicator light will flash indicating "Make Alternate Selection". To reset the health safety switch, open the front door of the machine and press the mode button eight (8) times. until the control board returns to the sales mode (00 appears on display). Close the front door of the machine, starting the health safety timer. After 30 minutes have elapsed (60 minutes if control board is set for 60 minutes), the control board will check the health control (products will be vended during the 30 minute time period) and if the temperature is above 45 degrees the unit will be taken out of service. If the temperature is below 45 degrees, the unit will operate normally and vend from any selection. When a route person comes to load the machine, when they open and close the front door of the machine, the health safety will automatically be reset. Should there be a power failure, the health safety will check the temperature inside the cold food area and if the temperature is below 45 degrees, it will continue to vend properly. If it is above 45 degrees, it will then shut down the machine. There is also a service diagnostic indicator on the L.E.D. to let the operator know the status of the Health Safety Switch. On the display on the right hand side, there is a decimal point that when the Health Safety is open (temperature above 45 degrees), the decimal point is illuminated. When the Health Safety switch is closed, the decimal light will not be illuminated.

HEALTH CONTROL TIMER SETUP

There is an option in this control board that will allow the operator to change the Health Control Time from 30 to 60 minutes. The time you choose is dependent upon the ambient environment conditions, time to load the machine and amount of warm products being loaded. The option from the factory will be set on 30 minutes. To change the Health Control time setting, open the front door of the machine and press the mode button located on the control board. Continue pressing the mode button until the digital display shows Ser7. Come around to the selection buttons on the front door and press selection button #3. The display will show the present status of the timer.

OFF = 30 minutes ON = 60 minutes

To change the status of the option, release the #3 selection button and press it again. The option will then change. To lock in this option, press the mode button on the control board until 00 appears on the digital display.



POWER BOX ASSEMBLY

The high voltage power supply is located in the bottom of the machine on the left side in the front area. The unit has circuit breakers which provide 110 volts and 24 volts to the machine. The circuit breakers function is from left to right. The first breaker to the left is to provide 24 volts to the control board. The second circuit breaker provides the 24 volts to the carousel motor assembly. The third circuit breaker provides 110 volts to the lights in the machine. Located inside of the power box is the ballast for the fluorescent lights, the step down transformer for the control board, step down transformer for the carousel motor, carousel rotation control relay and the RFI filter.



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

A. PAINTED SURFACES

All painted surfaces and the vinyl covered surfaces can be cleaned with a clean cloth and any common brand of household detergent. Do not use harsh abrasive materials on these surfaces, they will scratch the paint or vinyl.

B. VEND DOORS

The vend doors can be cleaned with any common brand of window cleaner and a soft cloth. DO NOT USE harsh abrasive cleaners on the doors. Never use paper products to clean the vend doors. It will cause scratches to appear.

DO NOT USE ANY KIND OF SOLVENT ON THE DOORS. Solvents will cause the vend doors to cloud up.

C. CLEAN the condenser area on the rear of the machine and small filter located on the front of the chiller unit as required.

D. LUBRICATE the following components every six months with white grease, grade 2 high/low temperature grease or equivalent, the top outer-door hinge, bottom outer-door hinge, door locking plates and inner door hinges.

COLD FOOD SANITATION

The following are the cleaning procedures for the cold food area. It is recommended that the local health inspector be consulted for full requirements on sanitation of cold food machines.

- 1. All surfaces that come into direct contact with food must be cleaned with warm water and a mild detergent at all regular service intervals.
- 2. After cleaning food contact surfaces rinse with clean, potable water.
- 3. Sanitize food contact surfaces with a good grade chemical sanitizing solution (chlorine, iodophor, etc.).
- 4. Allow all food contact surfaces to air dry.



SHIPPING POLICY

The following information is to assist you in assuring safe delivery of your merchandise and in expediting of freight damage claims.

Our terms of sale are F.O.B. our factory. The responsibility for damage in transit is the carrier's whether it be visible or concealed damage. We have taken every precaution to ensure safe arrival of this equipment, but our responsibility ceases the moment the shipment is turned over to the carrier.

Acceptance of this shipment by the carrier is an acknowledgment that the equipment was delivered to them in good condition and properly packed. The carrier who delivers this merchandise to your door is responsible for its safe delivery.

PROCEDURE FOR VISIBLE DAMAGE

- 1. IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO INSPECT ALL FREIGHT DELIVERIES, WHETHER MACHINES OR PARTS, IMMEDIATELY. If there is any visible damage you have the right to either refuse the merchandise or accept the damaged shipment. If you accept it, make certain that you have the delivery personnel note the nature and extent of damage on the freight bill.
- 2. After you determine the extent and cost of the damage, notify the delivering carrier's office by phone and confirm with a written notice within 15 days requesting an inspection of the damaged merchandise. Keep a copy of the inspection request for claim purposes. Do not destroy the packing material until shipment is inspected and claim is settled.
- 3. When the inspector arrives, ask for a claim form. In filing a claim, you may make a cash settlement with the carrier for the full invoice price of the merchandise or contact Polyvend Inc. at 1-501-327-1301 and make arrangements to have merchandise returned for repair and file a claim for repair charges. Do not return "DEADHEAD". Do not claim more than the cash price of the machine, plus freight.

SHOCK WATCH PROCEDURE

On each machine shipped out of Polyvend Inc., there is an indicator called a Shock Watch, which will turn from white to red if the machine has received a severe impact. The shock watch is a red hexagon shaped label mounted on the front door of the machine. Just above the shock watch will be a label on the outside of the machine with instructions on what to do when the machine is received and what to do if the shock watch has changed color from white to red.

Inspect the shock watch "IMMEDIATELY" upon receipt of the machine. DO NOT SIGN THE BILL OF LADING until you have inspected the shock watch to see if it has turned from white to red. If the shock watch has turned red, note this on the bill of lading. Inspect the machine "IMMEDIATELY" for damage both on the exterior and interior of the machine. If damage is found, follow the procedures for concealed damage.

PROCEDURE FOR CONCEALED DAMAGE

1. If there is no visible damage, YOU MUST OPEN THE SHIPMENT WITHIN 15 DAYS AND INSPECT FOR CONCEALED DAMAGE. If there is concealed damage, notify the delivering carrier by phone immediately asking for an inspection. Confirm the request in writing and keep a copy for claim purposes. If you fail to notify the carrier within 15 days of delivery by telephone and in writing, the freight company is no longer liable for damage and will probably refuse your claim. Do not destroy packing material until shipment is inspected and claim is settled.



2. After inspection by the carrier, file a claim for damages at once. On concealed damage, unless it can be proven that the carrier is responsible for the damage, they will probably want to settle on a compromise basis. Therefore, the faster you inspect your delivery and notify the carrier, the better the chances for full settlement. If the claim is disallowed, check on the possibility of a compromise.

PROCEDURES FOR SHORTAGES

- 1. If the shipment delivered to you is not in accordance with the quantity of cartons shown on your receipt, do not accept it until shortages are noted on the Freight Bill or Bill of Lading and signed by the truck driver. Failure to do this releases the carrier from any responsibility.
- 2. If the shorted item is not delivered within a reasonable time, file a claim with the delivering carrier for the invoice or cash price of that item.

NOTE: Claims for loss or damage will NOT BE DEDUCTED FROM YOUR INVOICE while you wait adjustment of such claims.



TROUBLESHOOTING

HEALTH CONTROL

- A. SYMPTOM: HEALTH CONTROL CIRCUIT DROPS OUT AND MACHINE SAYS "MAKE ALTERNATE SELECTION".
- Possible Cause: Temperature inside refrigerated area above 45 degrees. Use an accurate thermometer to check.
- 1: Possible Solution: Check cooling system:
 - A. Thermostat set too warm.
 - B. Chiller frosted up, cabinet too close to wall, minimum distance 6" from wall.
- 2: Possible Cause: Defective Health and Safety control.
- 2: Possible Solution: Remove power to control board. Unplug electronic health control harness from plug J-9 on control board. Install special jumper plug (contact Polyvend Service Department to obtain one) on control board plug J-9. Reset health control and if it does not kick out, health and safety control is defective. Replace.
- 3: Possible Cause: Defective wiring or wiring connection.
- 3: Possible Solution: Inspect wire harness for bad connection or break in wiring from health control sensor to control board. Using an ohmmeter with power removed, test each wire from the health control sensor to the connection on the control board for the health control.
- 4: Possible Cause: Defective control board.
- 4: Possible Solution: Replace control board.

CAROUSEL ASSEMBLY


- A. SYMPTOM: THE CAROUSEL WILL NOT ROTATE WHEN THE COLD FOOD "PRESS TO VIEW" BUTTON IS PRESSED.
- 1: Possible Cause: A delivery door is part way open.
- 1: Possible Solution: Make sure all delivery doors are closed.
- 2: Possible Cause: Press the "Press to View" bar, the carousel rotation relay should energize inside of the power box. Defective or incorrectly adjusted door switch arm on solenoid assembly. Try inside loading button. If carousel rotates, problem is in door side of carousel rotation system.
- 2: Possible Solution: Test each door switch. You can lift up on the arm of the door switch and an audible click should be heard. If not, adjust the switch arm until a click is heard when the arm is lifted. If the switch continues to not operate, check the switch out with an ohmmeter and replace if defective.
- 3: Possible Cause: The outside carousel "Press to View" keypad is defective.
- 3: Possible Solution: Replace keypad.



- 4: Possible Cause: Press loading switch inside cold food area. If carousel does not turn, the carousel motor is defective or no 24 volts is present.
- 4: Possible Solution: Check to insure that 24 volt is present. If voltage present, replace carousel motor. If 24 volts is present, check 10 amp circuit breaker to see if it is tripped. If circuit breaker is okay, check output of the carousel transformer.
- 5: Possible Cause: Defective wiring or wiring connections.
- 5: Possible Solution: Using the schematic for the Food King, check the electrical circuit from the power box to the carousel motor.
- 6: Possible Cause: Defective carousel rotation relay located inside of power box.
- 6: Possible Solution: Using a voltmeter, check to see if 24 volts is applied to the relay when the "Press to View" bar is pressed. If voltage is present, relay defective.
- B. SYMPTOM: CAROUSEL WILL NOT STOP ROTATING.
- 1: Possible Cause: Stepping switch on carousel motor assembly out of adjustment.
- 1: Possible Solution: Remove the top two trays in the carousel assembly, loosen the four screws on top of the motor mounting bracket holding the motor in place and move the motor closer to the stepping switch (only a slight amount of movement is necessary). Tighten the screws and test unit.
- 2: Possible Cause: Carousel motor brake defective.
- 2: Possible Solution: Replace carousel motor.






POWER BOX SCHEMATIC - FOOD KING




