**SUBJECT:** CONDENSATE (DRAIN) PAN

**MODELS:** All DNCB Venders.

**REASON:** To provide service drain pan assembly numbers and installation instructions.

**SERIAL BREAKS:** 0450-6365CU and higher have plastic drain pans with new fiberglass soakers.

0001-6158DR and higher have plastic train pans with fiberglass soakers. 0001-6121AR and higher have plastic drain pans with sponge soakers. 0001-2971AL to 0001-6121AR have metal drain pans with sponge soakers. 001-2283BD to 0001-2971AL have plastic drain pans with sponge soakers.

Prior to 001-2283BD have metal drain pans.

**ORDER:** 491,000,100.23 Service Drain Pan Assy.

1 - 491,012,000.03 Plastic Drain Pain Adapter Plate Assy. 2 - 900,301,650.01 Phil Pan Screw with washer #8-18 x 1/2

2 - 900,800,500.01 Keps nut #8-32

## DRAIN PAN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR VENDERS Serialized 0001-6121AR and Higher And venders prior to 0001-2971AL

- 1. Remove the front screw that secures the existing drain pan.
- 2. Remove the existing drain pan.
- 3. Remove the rear screw used to secure the back of the drain pan.
- 4. Install the Phil Pan Shoulder Screw (900,301,980.01) in the position you removed the screw in step 3.




Figure 1 Drain Pan

- 5. Place the plastic drain pan in position. Ensure the securing projection (see "A" fig. 1 on page 3) on the pan fits around the shoulder of the Phil Pan Shoulder Screw.
- 6. Secure the front of the plastic drain pan with a Phil Pan Screw with washer (900,301,650.01).
- 7. Ensure the drain hose is positioned in the drain pan.

## DRAIN PAN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR VENDERS Serialized 0001-2971AL to 0001-6121AR

- 1. Remove the front screw that secures the existing drain pan.
- 2. Remove the existing drain pan.
- 3. Remove the rear screw used to secure the back of the drain pan.




Figure 2 Drain Pan Adapter Plate

- 4. Place the plastic drain pan adapter plate (see fig. 2 on pg. 3). Note: Adapter only fits one way. (See fig. 2 on page 3 for proper positioning.)
- 5. Secure the adapter plate in position with two (2) Phil Pan Screws with washer (900,301,650.01). Note: Screws are installed in the positions the screws were removed in steps 1 and 3.
- 6. Place the drain pan in position on the adapter plate. Ensure the securing projections (see "A" fig. 1 on page 3) on the drain pan fit around the threadstuds on the adapter plate.
- 7. Secure the drain pan in position with two keps nuts (900,800,500.01).
- 8. Ensure the drain hose is positioned in the drain pan.



### **Installation Instructions:**

1. Remove the front screw that secures the existing drain pan.

- 2. Remove the existing drain pan.
- 3. Remove the rear screw used to secure the backside of the drain pan.
- 4. Place special drain pan in position. Note: The special drain pan is not secured to the base.
- 5. Ensure the drain hose is positioned in the drain pan.
