
REASON:

To provide a sealing compound that will adequately seal the Rain Guard and Trim. To provide a trough inside Select Panel above Select Switches to divert rain water which may get in coin slot.

On outside locations where the DNCB Vender may be subjected to heavy driving rain storms it might be possible for water to get by the Rain Guard and down in the top of the Vertical Trim - See Fig. 1.

Also, water may enter coin slot. Drain teeth are provided in all coin insert castings at entrance to coin chute. This water can drain down the inside face of select panel. The trough provided will divert the water over to side, away from select switches.
