REASON: To provide serial breaks for start up of polarized harnessing. The line or hot line is #2 wire which is the smaller terminal / socket in the harness.

| Pepsi, 7UP, Dr. Pepper, & Generic Venders: | | Polarization undetermined; occurred approximately 1984. |





**Cylinder Plug

When a non-polarized power harness is replaced with a polarized power harness, order 804,901,95x.x1 adapter lead standard female on one end and polarized male on the other end. When a non-polarized cabinet harness is replaced with a polarized cabinet harness, order 804,901,96x.x1 adapter lead standard male on one end and polarized female on the other end.
