SUBJECT: LIGHTED SIDE PANELS FOR PEPSI, SEVEN-UP, AND DR. PEPPER

MODELS: DNCB Curved Pepsi, Seven-Up, and Dr. Pepper venders.

NOTE: The Side Panel is shipped assembled and ready for

installation.

Before proceeding with installation read this bulletin carefully, especially: Installation on T-Model.

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TO INSTALL:


- 1. Installation of the side panel on the left side of the vender is shown. See figure 1.
- 2. Important: Wear safety glasses during kit installation.
- 3. On the side or sides to which the side panel is to be installed, remove vandal panel or panels. Use a sharp chisel to remove the rivets from the panel if secured by rivets.
- 4. Place side panel in position as shown in figure 1. The top of the side panel should be flush with the top of the cabinet. Push the side panel to the right and then towards the rear.
- 5. Let the flange of the retaining angle go tight against the cabinet flange. See figure 1.
- 6. Use the flange as a template and drill twelve (12) 9/64" holes in the cabinet's flange. Secure with #8-18 x 1/2" Self Drilling Screws provided. See figure 1. (Note: 24 screws are used to secure the side panel, 12 front and 12 rear.) Use the same procedure to secure the side panel at the rear.
- 7. INSTALLATION OF RIGHT HAND SIDE PANEL:


Use the same procedure to install the side panel on the right side except:


- A. Close and lock the main door.
- B. Place the lighted side panel in position (before drilling holes) so that there is sufficient clearance between the door and side panel for the door to close.
- 8. There is a socket on the bottom underside of each lighted side panel. When mounting two panels -- run one panel's electrical lead to the other panel, so that only one lead will be needed at the receptacle.
- 9. Install the new vandal panel to the main door. See figure 2. Secure with the bolts and nuts removed from the original vandal panel. Only one row of bolts can be used.
- 10. T-Model:
 - A. Use the same procedure for T-Models.


 EXCEPT: Reverse the retaining angle before making installation at the rear. See figure 4.
- 11. To replace lamps, remove front and rear retaining angles from the side panel.

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
