**SUBJECT:** COCA-COLA NORTH AMERICA VENDER / COOLER EQUIPMENT TAGS

**MODELS AFFECTED:** All Coca-Cola North American venders serialized 0001-6495CW and higher.

**REASON:** In cooperation with Coca-Cola, Dixie-Narco will be installing two Coca-Cola Vender / Cooler Equipment Tags on all Coca-Cola North American built equipment.

Below is a sample of the asset tags (see figure 1). Each tag will include bar coding along with verbal information. The verbal information will include: A) Ten character Asset Code / Equipment Number which identifies the manufacturer, production year, and production number; B) Up to ten character Item Code / Model Number which identifies the actual manufacturers model number; C) An alpha-numeric 13 character field for vender serial number assigned by Dixie-Narco.




**Equipment Tag Placement:**

1. One tag will be placed on the outside of the unit and one on the inside of the unit. See page 2 for examples of placements.


**DNCB Vender Tag Placement:**

Exterior: The equipment tag will be placed, while facing the front of the unit, on the bottom of the left side of the main door. See figure 2.

Interior: The equipment tag will be placed, while facing the front of the unit with the door open, on the top, inner left side wall. See figure 3.




**Cooler / Glass Front Vender Tag Placement**

Exterior: The equipment tag will be placed, while facing the front of the unit, on the bottom corner of the left side as close to the front as possible. See figure 4.

Interior: The equipment tag will be placed, while facing the front of the unit with the door open, on the top, inner left side wall. See figure 5.
